**ORDER STRIKING *PRO SE* MOTIONS [83, 86] AND DENYING  
MOTION FOR REVOCATION OF DETENTION ORDER [90]**

On April 18, 2020 and June 2, 2020 Defendant Cotton filed two *pro se* motions requesting immediate release from custody due to the COVID-19 pandemic. (ECF Nos. 83, 86.) On June 10, 2020, Defendant Cotton filed, through counsel, a motion for revocation of his detention order. (ECF No. 90.) On July 22, 2020 the Court held oral argument on these motions through audio-visual technology.
