ORDER

Children’s Report to the Court and Motion to Extend the Consent Decree for Two Years and for Additional Relief [207] is granted. Therefore, over objection, the consent decree shall be extended by two years and Defendant Bobbie Gregg, Acting Director of the Illinois Department of Children and Family Services, shall comply with the Children’s discovery requests as follows: (1) Defendant shall tender all the QA reviews completed since March 2012; (2) Defendant shall adopt a verifiable methodology for random sampling in its QA review process; (3) Defendant shall use only the reasons that are specified in the Decree to disqualify cases; (4) Defendant shall amend its policy so that sanctions can be given out based on QA reviews; and (5) Defendant shall comply with the Children’s December 18, 2013 discovery request.
