ORDER APPROVING MODIFICATION OF SECTION I.D.9.  
OF THE MODIFIED SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

---

Pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 60(b)(6), having reviewed the defendants' Unopposed Motion to Modify Section I.D.9. of the Modified Settlement Agreement, Approve the Proposed Notice to the Class, and Approve the Proposed Plan for Dissemination of Notice and Submission of Comments (the "Motion") and its attached exhibits; the defendants' Memorandum in Support of the Motion; and the defendants' Supplemental Memorandum in Support of the Motion and its supporting affidavits; and having received no comments or objections regarding the proposed Section I.D.9. modification, the Court for good cause shown hereby:

1. ORDERS that modifying Section I.D.9. of the Modified Settlement Agreement as set forth in the Motion constitutes just terms for and reasons warranting relief from the current provisions of Section I.D.9. of the Modified Settlement Agreement.

2. ORDERS that Section I.D.9. of the Modified Settlement Agreement shall be modified as follows (deleted language indicated by strike-through, new language indicated by underline):

At least the following percentages of children in BMCW custody within the period shall have had three or fewer placements ~~after January 1, 1999~~, during the previous 36 calendar months of their current episode in BMCW custody. The number of placements will exclude time-limited respite care placements and returns to the same caregiver after an intervening placement during the same out of care episode. Those children in BMCW custody through the Wraparound Milwaukee program shall be excluded from this calculation. Initial assessment center placements also will be excluded from the calculation.

Period 1 80%  
Period 2 82%  
Period 3 90%

The Second Modified Settlement Agreement reflecting this change will be endorsed by the Court on this date.

3. ORDERS that the effective date for this modification of Section I.D.9. shall be July 1, 2012.
