**NOTICE OF COMPLIANCE WITH 28 U.S.C. § 1715(b)**

Defendant Walt Disney World Co. (“Worldco”) hereby notifies the Court that on April 23, 2009, pursuant to the Class Action Fairness Act (“CAFA”), 28 U.S.C. § 1715(b), it provided individualized notices of the proposed class action settlement in this action to the Attorney General in all 50 States and the District of Columbia and to the United States Attorney General. The notices explained that a proposed settlement had been reached in this case and identified the case caption and that Worldco was sending the notice through its attorneys Kaye Scholer LLP.

In compliance with 28 U.S.C. § 1715(b)(1) through (8), Worldco’s CAFA notices also included information required by those statutory provisions and copies of documents from this case, including but not limited to the original and two amended complaints filed by the plaintiffs; the notice of proposed settlement sent out to identified class members on May 1, 2009, which includes information on the fairness hearing set for June 3 and possibly June 4, 2009 in Orlando, Florida; the proposed class action settlement; and several scheduling notices and judicial opinions relating to these materials.
