ORDER PERMITTING ENTRY UPON LAND

As stated at the hearing on the record held on November 21, 2007, the parties have agreed that plaintiff-intervenor, the United States of America, will be provided entry and full access to the land and entire space within the footprint of the University of Michigan football stadium and its surrounding grounds. The terms of the stipulation are as follows:

1. The United States and its expert will be provided full and unfettered access and

entry to every space at the football stadium and on the surrounding grounds in order for the United States to conduct a survey of the football stadium and the surrounding grounds.

2. The full and unfettered access to the football stadium and the grounds will begin at noon on Tuesday, November 27, 2007, and will continue for a minimum of five consecutive days. If the United States determines that it needs additional time to complete the survey, the University has agreed that it does not object to any additional days for completion of that survey.
3. An illustrative list, providing the minimum, but not the maximum, spaces that the United States will be given such unfettered access as part of its survey will be provided to the University by the United States by noon on Monday, November 26, 2007. The United States will also provide the University with the identity of the individuals who will be at the survey by noon on that same Monday.
4. Also by noon on Monday, November 26, 2007, the University will provide the United States with a construction schedule or list specifically describing what, if any, work had been done, the scope of that work and the location of all such work, since November 16, 2007, up to and including the last day of the survey.

In light of the foregoing stipulation, the United States' Emergency Motion for Entry Upon Land is GRANTED.
