
IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED by and among the undersigned counsel for the respective parties  
that:

1. In order to permit the issues in this case to be heard after a factual record is developed in discovery and the legal issues are fully briefed, Defendant will refrain from performing any new involuntary transfers of the public assistance, Food Stamps, and/or Medicaid cases of recipients of public benefits from Job Centers to WeCARE job centers through the date of the hearing on plaintiffs' motion for a preliminary injunction, December 13, 2005. Five business days before release or mailing, defendant will provide copies to counsel for plaintiffs of

notices regarding any voluntary transfers of the public assistance, Food Stamps, and/or Medicaid cases of recipients of public benefits.

2. A facsimile copy of this stipulation shall be deemed an original for all purposes.


