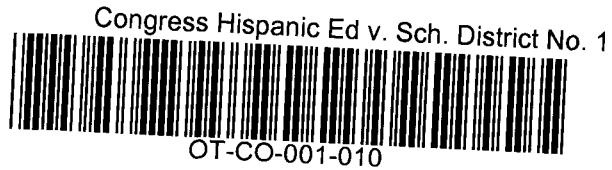

Hearing: Fairness Hearing

Court in session: 1:30 p.m.

Counsel appearances.

**Dr. Wayne Eckerling** (2:56) makes statements to the court followed by questions by Mr. Roos, Mr. Glassman and the court.

**Jose Perea** makes statements to the court followed by questions by Mr. Roos and the court.

**Susan Edwards** (4:20) makes statements to the court.

Mr. Jackson and Mr. Roos ask the court to sign off on the plan and approve the recommended monitor. Mr. Glassman agrees. Ms. Benavidez asks the court to consider the suggestion their group made.

The court makes findings and speaks on the role of the court. **The court orders the plan to be accepted** and counsel are asked to prepare a consent decree for the court to sign.

The court speaks on the changes in the school system through the years from the 1970s to today.

TESTIMONY REGARDING PROPOSED SETTLEMENT**


