ORDER FOR ADMINISTRATIVE CLOSURE

On June 16, 1999, this court, after hearing, entered its Order Approving English Language Acquisition Program. That order constituted a final judgment resolving all matters at issue in this civil action. It directs implementation of an English Language Acquisition Program and monitoring as set forth as Joint Exhibit A and Joint Exhibit B filed with the court with the proposal to settle class action pursuant to Rule 23(e) on April 30, 1999. These programs provide that the court will receive annual reports from the Monitor, as required, and the court is to retain jurisdiction for 3 years beginning with the 1999-2000 school year, following which any party may apply to the court for an order of dismissal or

such other orders as may be appropriate. Because the case is no longer in active litigation, it is, pursuant to D.C.COLO. LR 41.1A ,

ORDERED that the Clerk shall close this civil action administratively subject to reopening for such action as may be necessary to oversee implementation of the program, and to take such action as may be requested on the initiative of the Monitor or any parties in interest.
