On February 21, 2013, the U.S. Department of Education, Office for Civil Rights (OCR), received the above-referenced complaint you filed with OCR against Hanover College (College) alleging retaliation.


Specifically, the complaint alleged that in (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) the College subjected you to retaliation for filing a sexual harassment grievance with the College when it refused to provide you a copy of its investigative file concerning your grievance and denied you (b)(6), (b)(7)(C)

OCR was advised that you and the College signed an agreement which the parties agree resolves the complaint. A copy of the agreement is enclosed. OCR is, therefore, closing the complaint effective the date of this letter.

We appreciate your willingness to have this complaint mediated and are pleased that we were able to help you resolve this matter. Please note that OCR is not a party to the agreement and will not monitor the agreement. If the College fails to implement the agreement, you may file a new complaint with OCR. Consistent with our complaint procedures, OCR would address the complaint allegation(s), and not the alleged breach of the agreement.
