RE: IM Status Report dated August 9, 2018

Please find the Independent Monitor Status Report dated August 9, 2018 attached for your review. Following a brief introduction, the report is organized into two major sections. First, the IMs provide an executive summary of the status of compliance for the targeted monitoring activities and corrective actions for the LEAs requiring targeted, onsite follow-up monitoring visits during the spring 2018 school term of the 2017-2018 school year from March 1-13, 2018. Specifically, this included twelve schools requiring corrective action plans (CAPs) and six schools requiring intensive corrective action plans (ICAPs) during the 2017-2018 school year. Second, the IMs provide recommendations for addressing continued compliance with the provisions of the CJ. In relation, there are three appendices attached to the IM status report including: a) summary of substantial compliance status across areas of the CJ from the 2015-2016 school year through the 2017-2018 school year.; b) monitoring documents received from the LDOE for the schools identified for targeted, onsite follow-up monitoring visits as a result of requiring a CAP during the 2017-2018 school year and related monitoring comparison tables; and c) monitoring documents received from the LDOE for the schools identified for targeted, onsite follow-up monitoring visits as a result of requiring an ICAP during the 2017-2018 school year and related monitoring comparison tables.

We again want to express our sincere appreciation to the Parties for their assistance in providing materials and information needed to complete the current IM Status Report dated August 9, 2018. We also wish to acknowledge representatives of the LDOE, OPSB, and Counsel for the Plaintiffs for their complete collaboration in responding to requests for information and cooperation during scheduled phone conferences and on-site meetings during the 2017-2018 school year.
