O R D E R


By Consent Decree entered February 9, 2010, the Title IX claim raised by the United States against the Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County ("Metro") (Docket Entry No. 516) has been resolved and settled. By Order entered February 9, 2010, the minor settlement resolving the matters in controversy between Plaintiff and Metro was approved (Docket Entry No. 517). The only remaining parties are Plaintiff Cumberland Trust and Investment Company as next friend and Trustee of Gilberto Kelley Lopez and Defendant Genesis Learning Centers.

Accordingly, the following motions in limine filed by Metro¹ are hereby DENIED as moot: Docket Entry Nos. 314, 316, 318, 324,

330, 332, 334, 345, and 347. The Motion in Limine (Docket Entry No. 326) filed by the United States is likewise DENIED as moot.
