





ORDER

The Defendant's Motion for Summary Judgment and the Plaintiff's Cross Motion for Partial Summary Judgment were considered at a hearing in chambers on February 4, 1998. For the reasons discussed in the accompanying Opinion, the Defendant's motion is hereby GRANTED on the issue of reasonable accommodation and DENIED on the issues of disability and release if claims. Because the issue of reasonable accommodation is dispositive of the Plaintiff's entire claim, this case is hereby DISMISSED with prejudice, each party to bear its own costs. The Plaintiff's motion is therefore MOOT.
