

ORDER

At the conclusion of the hearing conducted on May 23, 2007, Jefferson County Probate Judge Alan King, acting in his capacity as Chairman of the Citizens Supervisory Commission, acknowledged that the attempted appointment of Ms. L. Corlene Williams to the position of Chair of the Personnel Board of Jefferson County (“Board”) is void, and affirmed that he will promptly administer an oath of office to Mr. Alfred F. Smith, Jr., who was appointed by this court to the position of Board

Chair on April 25, 2007.¹ Judge King is directed to promptly take all steps necessary to effect his affirmations. In view of the foregoing, as well as consideration of the record of proceedings conducted on May 23rd, any further proceedings pursuant to the order entered on May 18, 2007² are unnecessary. Finally, the motion to reconsider filed by Judge King,³ and the motion to dismiss filed by Reverend Steve Small,⁴ are DENIED as moot.
