

- 1 1. Absent stipulation of the parties, documents produced pursuant to the
- 2 subpoena shall be shown only to counsel of record for the parties,
- 3 administrative personnel working for counsel of record in connection with this
- 4 case, and duly retained expert witnesses;
- 5 2. Absent stipulation of the parties, documents pursuant to the subpoena shall be
- 6 used only in connection with the present litigation, and not in connection with
- 7 other litigation;
- 8 3. Testimony concerning these documents, which is adduced at deposition, shall
- 9 be segregated from other testimony and sealed, and to the extent these
- 10 documents must be used in connection with any pretrial motions, the
- 11 documents must be submitted separately under seal.

12 This order is subject to modification upon presentation of a stipulation of the parties or, for
 13 good cause shown, upon duly noticed motion.
