1 Defendants Michael Barbee and Rock-N-Roll, LLC that Defendants the subjected
2 claimants identified to the Court in the EEOC's application for default judgment
3 to sexual harassment and/or retaliation in violation of Title VII of the Civil Rights
4 Act of 1964, as amended ("Title VII"). 42 USC. §2000e *et seq.*


5 2. Defendant Michael Barbee is the alter ego of Defendant Rock-N-
6 Roll, LLC and as such each is liable for damages as set forth below.

7 3. Defendants Michael Barbee and Rock-N-Roll, LLC are permanently
8 enjoined from subjecting employees to sexual harassment in violation of Title
9 VII.

10 4. Defendants Michael Barbee and Rock-N-Roll, LLC are permanently
11 enjoined from subjecting employees to retaliation for engaging in protected
12 activity under Title VII.

13 5. Because the EEOC is the only plaintiff in this action, the Court
14 awards damages to EEOC on behalf the claimants in the amount \$200,000. The
15 Regional Attorney for the EEOC's Los Angeles District Office shall make the
16 determination regarding the distribution of damages to each of the claimants.
