**STIPULATION AND ORDER REGARDING
IMPLEMENTATION OF SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT**

Since the Fairness Hearing in this matter on May 12, 2000, the issuance of the August 22, 2000 Order Granting Final Approval to the Class Settlement Agreement, and the issuance of the October 3, 2000 Memorandum Opinion, the parties have had further discussions concerning the dispute over the timing and distribution of the settlement payment in this case (which the parties have briefed to the Court), the dispute over the meaning of the term Final Court Approval in the Settlement Agreement, and the objections and appeal filed by non-plaintiff class member Richard Delaney. The parties now stipulate and agree as follows:

1. The dispute concerning the timing of the payment and distribution of the settlement proceeds, previously briefed to the court, is moot.


2. The only objections to the settlement were those of non-plaintiff class members Delaney and Howard Helman. Both have withdrawn their objections. Because Mr. Delaney has


moved to dismiss his appeal with prejudice, defendants hereby withdraw their motion to require Mr. Delaney to post an appeal bond.




