JUDGMENT IN A CIVIL CASE

**JURY VERDICT.** This action came before the Court for a trial by jury. The issues have been tried and the jury rendered its verdict.

**DECISION BY THE COURT.** This action came to trial before the Court on the issues of back pay, medical expenses, and prospective injunctive relief. The issues have been tried and a decision has been rendered.

**IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that judgment is entered in favor of EEOC and against Greenville Ford-Mercury, Inc. in the amount of \$14,706 in compensatory damages for emotional harm, \$35,294 in punitive damages, \$526 in back pay and interest, and \$949 in compensation for medical expenses – for a total award of \$51,475.

Greenville Ford-Mercury, Inc. is permanently enjoined from discriminating against any person on the basis of disability and must comply with the permanent injunction described in the Court's August 6, 2002 Order.
