**ORDER AUTHORIZING FINAL DISTRIBUTION  
OF BALANCE OF UNDISTRIBUTED SETTLEMENT FUND**

Before the Court is the Joint Motion of Plaintiffs and Plaintiff Intervener to distribute the balance of the Settlement Fund in accordance with the terms of the Consent Decree. The Court has been informed of the identity of the three not-for-profit organizations chosen by Class Counsel and Counsel for the EEOC, and is satisfied that each organization works in whole or in part to benefit women's workplace interests. The Court therefore approves the distribution of the balance of the Settlement Fund to :

1. Twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000.00) to Women In Charge, a St. Louis-based non-profit organization, at 1340 Partridge Avenue, St. Louis, Missouri,

63130.

2. Fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000.00) to Dress for Success, a Wichita, Kansas non-profit organization, at 1422 North High Street, Wichita, Kansas, 67203.

3. The balance of the Settlement Fund (about \$45,000.00) to Workplace Fairness, a national non-profit organization, at 44 Montgomery Street, Suite 2080, San Francisco, California, 94104.

Distribution of these funds shall be as soon as practicable, but not later than December 15, 2004.
