**ORDER OF PARTIAL DISMISSAL**

The Court having been advised by counsel for the plaintiffs and counsel for the defendants that they have firmly agreed upon a resolution of their dispute, and that they need only execute releases and otherwise comply with the terms of their agreement;

**IT IS ORDERED** that all claims asserted by plaintiffs against all named defendants are hereby dismissed without costs, but without prejudice to the right, upon good cause shown, within sixty days, to seek summary judgment enforcing the compromise if it is not consummated by that time. With the consent of the parties, the Court retains jurisdiction over the settlement agreement for enforcement purposes.

The claims asserted by the United States Equal Employment Opportunity Commission against Lakeside Imports, Inc. are unaffected by this order.


