


positions comparable to that of Ms. Alfortish. On July 13, 2000, upon learning that she would not receive any other pay increase, Ms. Alfortish resigned due to the fact that she had felt humiliated and that her working conditions had become so intolerable that she felt forced to resign, given her length of tenure of service and the actions of the defendant in continually undervaluing her service as an employee. Additionally, Ms. Alfortish avers that the constant degradation, harassment, badgering and/or humiliation by the employer culminating in the 'pay raise of a menial amount' was calculated to encourage Ms. Alfortish's resignation. Ms. Alfortish maintains that the actions of the defendants results in her constructive discharge."

WHEREFORE, plaintiffs, Melanie Kramer and Sylvia Alfortish, pray that this Third Amended Complaint be deemed sufficient and permitted to be filed herein.


