I am in receipt of Mr. Ingle's letter of April 14, 2005.

Mr. Ingle is correct that I erroneously entered an order denying defendant's motion for summary judgment. My recollection failed me when I was reviewing the case management report that prompted my letter order of April 13, 2005.

Accordingly, my April 13, 2005 order denying defendant's motion for summary judgment is withdrawn. The motion will remain pending while you conduct your mediation. If the mediation fails, I will decide whether to grant or deny the motion or to postpone ruling on it, awaiting the deposition of Ms. Hogg and supplemental briefing.
