ORDER OF FINAL APPROVAL AND FINAL DISMISSAL

The Court has before it EEOC's Motion for Final Approval of Settlements and Final Approval of Distribution Allocation and to Cancel the Fairness Hearing Since No Objections were Received. The Court is satisfied that the EEOC claimants have received the approved Notices of the Settlements and have had a reasonable opportunity to make objections pursuant to the Court's May 24, 2000 Order and the instructions contained in the Notices. Accordingly, upon the EEOC having advised the Court that no objections to either the Settlement Agreements or the distribution allocation were received, there is no longer a need for a fairness hearing. The Settlements and Distribution Allocation are GRANTED final approval and all claimants may receive their distributions in accordance with the EEOC's proposed allocations. This matter may be Dismissed with prejudice.
