
**ORDER**

For the reasons stated on the record on June 19, 2009, and as outlined in the Report and Recommendation of July 1, 2009, the Court hereby ENTERS JUDGMENT against Defendant Worthington, Moore, & Jacobs, Inc., and AWARDS the Claimants the following relief:

- (i) Claimant Jill Hennen Iovacchini: back pay of \$75,256.00; compensatory damages and punitive damages of \$50,000.00; post-judgment interest from the date of final judgment;
- (ii) Claimant Elizabeth Ford: back pay of \$21,966.00; compensatory damages and punitive damages of \$50,000; post-judgment interest from the date of final judgment;
- (iii) Claimant Diana Bantom: compensatory damages and punitive damages of \$50,000.00; post-judgment interest from the date of final judgment;
- (iv) Claimant Lynne Geers: back pay of \$17,734.00; compensatory damages and punitive damages of \$50,000.00; post-judgment interest from the date of final judgment;
- (v) Claimant Melanie Sandy Goldsberry: back pay of \$75,042.00; compensatory damages and punitive damages of \$50,000.00; post-judgment interest from the date of final judgment;

- (vi) Claimant Laura Thomas: back pay of \$114,737.00; compensatory damages and punitive damages of \$50,000; post-judgment interest from the date of final judgment;
- (vii) Claimant Nancy Guzman: back pay of \$23,591.00; compensatory damages and punitive damages of \$50,000.00; post-judgment interest from the date of final judgment.
