**ORDER ON PLAINTIFF'S MOTION TO COMPEL DISCOVERY
AND MOTION TO EXTEND DISCOVERY**

Plaintiff's Motion to Compel Discovery and Motion to Extend Discovery having been heard on December 12, 2006,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Plaintiff's Motion is granted in part and, within 14 days of the date of this Order:

1. Defendant will provide a complete response to Interrogatory No. 16 and will identify by name, race, date of hire, job title at the time of hire and each job position held, each person hired by Defendant from October 1, 2002 through September 30, 2005;

2. Defendant will provide a complete response to Interrogatory No. 20 and will identify by name and race each former Vision Metals employee hired by Defendant from December 1, 2002 through September 30, 2005;

3. Defendant will provide a complete response to Document Request No. 22 and will produce the complete personnel files, including but not limited to the disciplinary and training records, of each former Vision Metals employee hired by Defendant through September 30, 2005;

4. Discovery is extended for a period of ninety (90) days to March 31, 2007. No further extensions of discovery will be granted. The court will issue an amended scheduling order.
