ORDER

Currently before the Court are the following motions (1) Defendant's Motion to Compel Responses to Interrogatories [doc. #58]; (2) Defendant's Motion to Modify the Case Management Order [doc. #60-1]. A hearing was held on September 7, 2006, and the Court heard arguments from the parties on the Motions.

After Considering the Issues, the court will grant Defendant's motion to compel. Plaintiff shall have 30 days to provide all remaining answers to interrogatories. Plaintiff's objections to providing e-mail addresses is overruled, as is Plaintiff's objection to information regarding claimants' sale of their books of business. Plaintiff will provide information regarding the sale as well as the terms of the agreement not to compete.

Accordingly,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Defendant's motion to Compel is **GRANTED** and Plaintiff's objections are **OVERRULED**. Plaintiff shall have 30 days to respond to all interrogatories.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Defendant's motion to modify the Case Management order is held in abeyance pending parties filing a Joint Proposed Amended Case Management Order no later than September 25, 2006.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the November 6, 2006 trial setting is VACATED. The Court expects to rule on Plaintiff's motion for Summary Judgment [doc. #42] and Defendant's motion for Summary Judgment [doc. #52] in early October.
