Opinion

DECISION AND ORDER

SCULLIN, District Judge:

*1 A motion having been made by plaintiffs seeking a preliminary injunction order restricting defendant Miller Brewing Company's ("Miller") communications with putative class members regarding Miller's severance program, and that motion having come on to be heard on February 3, 1994 by order to show cause, it is hereby

ORDERED, that plaintiffs' motion for a preliminary injunction restricting defendant's communications with putative class members regarding Miller's severance program is denied in all respects, and it is further

ORDERED that plaintiffs' request for an order mandating the inclusion of a notice of a class meeting in Miller's severance package is denied, all in accordance with the decision of this Court issued from the bench on February 7, 1994.
