IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that pursuant to the March 31, 2009 Opinion and Order, the Court GRANTS Honda of America, Mfg., Inc.'s motion to enforce resolution. Final judgment is entered in favor of Honda of America, Mfg., Inc. and against the EEOC and Monica Ways, dismissing this action with prejudice. The judgment shall reflect that the Court retains jurisdiction to enforce the terms of the May 12, 2008 settlement agreements, and to reopen the case for good cause shown if the terms of the settlement agreements are not fulfilled. The Court also retains jurisdiction to determine, separately, whether Honda of America, Mfg., Inc. is entitled to fees and costs in connection with its efforts to enforce the settlement agreements.
