Title: Motion to compel discovery

Before the Court is an unopposed motion by Plaintiff to compel Defendant La Cruz Azul to respond to Plaintiff's requests for discovery. The Court hereby grants the motion and orders Cruz Azul to hand deliver to Plaintiff's counsel by May 1, 2000, a full response to all of the EEOC's discovery requests. Additionally, the Court extends the deadline for the EEOC to conduct discovery. It shall have until June 15, 2000, to conduct additional discovery. This deadline applies to the EEOC only, as Cruz Azul has not requested an extension nor has it demonstrated why it should be afforded additional time to conduct discovery. The Court further orders Cruz Azul to make its officials available to be deposed by Plaintiff by May 10, 2000. Any further dilatory tactics by Cruz Azul shall result in the imposition of sanctions. Failure to comply with any terms in this order shall result in the imposition of sanctions, including Cruz Azul's being entered into default.
