**ORDER ON PLAINTIFF EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY COMMISSION'S
MOTION TO COMPEL DISCOVERY AND FOR EXTENSION OF 30 DAYS TO
SUPPLEMENT ITS DISCOVERY RESPONSES**

Upon motion of Plaintiff Equal Employment Opportunity Commission (EEOC), the submission of written briefs by EEOC and Defendant Northwest Airlines, Inc. (Defendant), and oral arguments, it is hereby ordered as follows:

1. A protective order ^{*JTA*} ~~identical to Exhibit A hereto,~~ is hereby contemporaneously being signed and entered by the Magistrate. Following entry of the protective order, Defendant shall respond, to the extent previously agreed upon by EEOC and Defendant, to Interrogatory No. 18 and Request for Production No. 3.

This document entered on the docket sheet in compliance with Rule 58 and/or 79(a) FRCP on 1-10-02

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
2. To the extent previously agreed upon by EEOC and Defendant, Defendant shall respond to Request for Production No. 7 and Request for Production No. 15.

3. With respect to Request for Production No. 8, in addition to producing its corporate Human Resources chart for positions involved in hiring Equipment Service Employees for Defendant's Memphis, Tennessee facility, Defendant shall identify any official of Defendant who interacted with the Park Nicollet Clinic - Airport (formerly "Airport Medical Clinic") in establishing, requiring, receiving, or consulting about the document entitled Northwest Airlines Equipment Service Job Descriptions and Medical Recommendations and the document attached hereto as Exhibit B.

4. With respect to Request for Production No. 9, Defendant shall produce a list of all Americans with Disabilities Act lawsuits filed against it from January 1, 1998 to present.

5. EEOC shall have 15 days following receipt of the information described herein solely for the purpose of supplementing its written discovery responses to reflect the information received from Defendant.

11. Elbow-mild
 Limit push/pull and occasional lifting to 50 lbs max.
 Limit carrying and frequent lifting to 20 lbs max.
 Limit repetitive tapping, clamping and repetitive wrist motion to occasional.

12. Elbow-moderate/severe
 Limit push/pull and occasional lifting to 20 lbs max.
 Limit carrying and frequent lifting to 10 lbs max.
 No repetitive tapping, clamping, repetitive wrist motion and/or operating vibrating tools.

13. Wrist/CTS-mild
 Limit push/pull and occasional lifting to 50 lbs.
 Limit carrying and frequent lifting to 20 lbs max.
 Limit tapping, clamping, heavy grasping, repetitive wrist motion and/or operating vibrating tools to occasional.

14. Wrist/CTS-moderate/severe
 Limit push/pull and occasional lifting to 20 lbs max.
 Limit carrying and frequent lifting to 10 lbs max.
 No tapping, clamping, heavy grasping, repetitive wrist motion and/or operating vibrating tools.

15. Knee-mild
 Limit push/pull and occasional lifting to 50 lbs max.
 Limit carrying and frequent lifting to 20 lbs max.
 Limit squatting and kneeling to occasional. Avoid prolonged squatting.
 Limit climbing, twisting and turning to occasional.

16. Knee-moderate/severe
 Limit push/pull and occasional lifting to 20 lbs max.
 Limit carrying and frequent lifting to 10 lbs max.
 No squatting, kneeling, climbing, twisting or turning.

17. Seizure disorder
 No working at unprotected heights above 5 feet.
 No driving/operating vehicles and/or heavy equipment.
 No working rotating shafts.
 No working alone.

18. Insulin dependent diabetes
 No working at unprotected heights above 5 feet.
 No driving/operating vehicles and/or heavy equipment.
 No working rotating shafts.
 No working alone.

19. Audio
 No working in areas requiring normal hearing (see standard) in both ears.

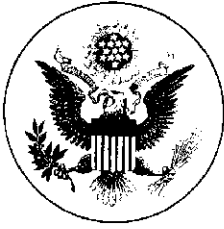
