MOTION OF PLAINTIFF UNITED STATES
FOR ENTRY OF JUDGMENT AND FOR RELIEF

Plaintiff United States hereby moves this Court:

1. To conclude that those deputy positions in the Patrick County Sheriff's Department which the United States contends were unlawfully denied Stephanie Ressel, Doris Scales, Wanda Hylton and Kathy Sheppard were not exempt from coverage under Section 701(f) of Title VII, 42 U.S.C. 2000e(f);

2. To conclude that defendant Sheriff of Patrick County has engaged in discriminatory employment practices against women, including the afore-named individuals, in violation of Title VII; and

3. To enter judgment for the United States, as well as to grant that relief requested by the United States.
