HEREBY ORDERED** that :

1. The funds held in Treasury Department, Account No. 45X675, representing monies held in trust for the Claimants in EEOC v. Future Shop, Inc., C98-1369CEEEOC be transferred and deposited into the registry of the Court. Pursuant to Local Rule GR 6(a), the Court orders that the funds be deposited in an interest-bearing account(s) in the Court's designated financial institution. The EEOC shall file motions for disbursement of the registry funds, pursuant to Local Rule GR 6(b), for the payment of the Settlement Fund Administrator's



administrative costs and at the point the Administrator has identified the specific claimants entitled to relief and the amount to be paid each.

2. The Settlement Fund Administrator is allowed an additional 90 days, as needed, to accomplish the mailing contemplated under paragraph 25 of the Consent Decree approved by the Court on April 20, 1999. It is understood that all subsequent steps following this mailing, including the final identification of claimants and mailing of individual checks, is timed to follow from the date of the initial mailing, which is now extended by 90 days.
