**~~PROPOSED~~ ORDER GRANTING PLAINTIFFS' UNOPPOSED MOTION
FOR A PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION AND STAY OF PROCEEDINGS**

Before this Court is Plaintiffs' unopposed motion for a preliminary injunction and stay of proceedings. This Court grants the motion and hereby orders as follows:

1. Plaintiffs' unopposed motion for a preliminary injunction and stay of proceedings is


GRANTED.

2. Defendants, their officers, agents, servants, successors in office, employees, attorneys, and those acting in concert or participation with them are ENJOINED until 30 days after the mandate issues from the Seventh Circuit in *Korte v. Sebelius*, No. 12-3841 (7th Cir.) and *Grote Indus. LLC v. Sebelius*, 13-077 (7th Cir.), from enforcing against Hart Electric LLC, H.I. Cable LLC, their employee health plan(s), or their insurer(s) the statute and regulations that require Plaintiffs to provide employees insurance coverage for “[a]ll Food and Drug Administration approved contraceptive methods, sterilization procedures, and patient education and counseling for all women with reproductive capacity,” 77 Fed. Reg. 8725, as well as any penalties, fines, assessments, or enforcement actions for non-compliance, including those found in 26 U.S.C. §§ 4980D, 4980H, and 29 U.S.C. §§ 1132, 1185d.

3. All proceedings in this case are stayed until thirty days after the mandate issues from the United States Court of Appeals in the consolidated cases of *Korte v. Sebelius*, No. 12-3841 (7th Cir.) and *Grote Indus. LLC v. Sebelius*, 13-077 (7th Cir.).

4. No bond shall be required of Plaintiffs.
