Autocam Corporation, Autocam Medical, and their owners appeal the denial of a preliminary injunction in their action before the district court challenging the implementation of the contraception-coverage provisions in the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act. The plaintiffs moved for an injunction pending appeal and to expedite the appeal. We denied the motion for an injunction pending appeal, but granted the motion to expedite. The plaintiffs now move for reconsideration, drawing our attention to additional decisions rendered after our decision that support their position. Upon consideration, we conclude that reconsideration is unnecessary.

The motion for reconsideration is **DENIED**.

Rogers, J., dissenting. I would grant the motion for reconsideration.
