ORDER

AND NOW, this 14th day of August, 2014, upon consideration of Plaintiffs’ “Amended Motion for Preliminary Injunction” (Doc. No. 62) and in light of the United States Supreme Court’s ruling in Burwell v. Hobby Lobby Stores, Inc., 134 S. Ct. 2751 (2014), it is hereby **ORDERED** that Defendants are preliminarily **ENJOINED** from enforcing against Plaintiffs, their group health plan, and the group health insurance coverage provided in connection with that plan, the statute and regulations that require Plaintiffs to provide their employees coverage for “[a]ll Food and Drug Administration approved contraceptive methods, sterilization procedures, and patient education and counseling for all women with reproductive capacity,” 77 Fed. Reg. 8725 (Feb. 15, 2012). This Order applies only to requirements regarding the provision of coverage for the contraceptive services to which Plaintiffs object on religious grounds. It should not be construed as applying to any other healthcare coverage required by law, including coverage of the other services required by the regulations regarding Women’s Preventive Healthcare.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that no bond is required.
