
JOINT MOTION TO TERMINATE CONSENT ORDER

Pursuant to Rule 60(b)(6), Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, and Section V of the 2004 Consent Order entered in this case, the United States and First American Bank (“the Bank”) jointly move the Court for an order terminating the current Consent Order in this case.

On July 16, 2004, this Court entered a Consent Order resolving the United States’ claims regarding the Bank’s compliance with the Fair Housing Act, 42 U.S.C. §§ 3601-3619, and the Equal Credit Opportunity Act, 15 U.S.C. §§ 1691-1691f. That Order was to terminate in October 2009, three months after submission of the Bank’s fifth annual report to the United States, or at any time after the Order had been in effect for four years upon joint motion of the parties, if the Bank had fully complied with all the terms of the Order.

The parties agree that First American Bank has fulfilled its affirmative obligations under the 2004 Consent Order and is in substantial compliance therewith. On that basis, the parties jointly move this Court to terminate the Consent Order pursuant to the provisions of that Order and of Rule 60(b)(6), which provides that a court may relieve a party from a final judgment or order for “any other reason that justifies relief.” A proposed order in word perfect has been e-mailed.


