ORDER

Pursuant to the “2010 Revision to the 2001 Plan for Compliance and Conclusion of *Evans v. Fenty*,”¹ (“2010 Plan”), the Special Master, Clarence J. Sundram, has submitted a report and recommendation regarding defendants’ certification of compliance with the remaining outcome criteria for Goal A.4 – Restricted Control Procedures. (See Special Master’s Report and Recommendation Regarding Restricted Control Procedures – Part II, September 5, 2014 [ECF No. 1487] (“R&R”).) Defendants filed their certification of compliance on April 1, 2014. (*Id.* at 2.) The Special Master now recommends that the Court find that defendants “have met their burden of proof of compliance with respect to Restricted Control Procedures.” (*Id.* at 7.) (R&R at 8.) The parties had 30 days to file objections to the Special Master’s report. No

objections have been filed.

Accordingly, upon consideration of the Special Master's Report and Recommendation, the lack of any objections thereto, and the entire record herein, it is hereby

ORDERED that the Court **APPROVES AND ADOPTS** the Special Master's Report and Recommendation Regarding Restricted Control Procedures – Part II [ECF No. 1487]; and it is further

ORDERED that defendants have achieved compliance with the remaining outcome criteria for Goal A.4 and the underlying court orders as set forth in the 2010 Plan.
