**Stipulated Agreement on Disengagement Process For 1998 Audit Recommendations and
Appendix A Areas**


The Plaintiffs and Defendants enter into this Agreement to clarify the process for disengagement of those remaining obligations under the Order Adopting Joint Stipulation entered May 5, 2005, (Appendix A) and obligations incurred as a result of the 1998 Audit Recommendations. Pursuant to this Agreement, those obligation will now be resolved in accordance with ¶¶ 44-45 of the Joint Stipulation on Disengagement (JSD) and adoption of those procedures constitutes the preferred mechanism for disengagement of those obligations by the parties.

Consistent with the JSD, the defendants may seek to disengage a topic area in Appendix A (i.e. case management, quality enhancement, incident management, behavior, crisis, sexuality, supported employment, DVR, and day services) when they believe that all action steps in that topic area have been completed. Consistent with prior practices of the parties, the defendants may seek to disengage the 1998 audit recommendations when all recommendations for that year have been completed.


Failure to implement a topic area in Appendix A will not prevent partial disengagement of the Court's supervision. Plaintiffs may file a motion to reestablish the Court's supervision over such provision if they believe the partially disengaged obligation has not been maintained.

WHEREFORE the parties seek that all provisions of the Joint Stipulation on Disengagement be applied and applicable to those remaining obligations of the Appendix A and 1998 Audit Recommendations.
