FLOOR AMENDMENT

TO

85 -- H 6395, As Amended

An Act to Provide Authority to Issue Bonds and Notes to Finance the 1985
Special Capital Development Program

Mr. Speaker:

I hereby move to amend 85 -- H 6395, As Amended, entitled "An Act to Provide Authority to Issue Bonds and Notes to Finance the 1985 Special Capital Development Program," as follows:

In Section 1, on page 2, between lines 22 and 23 delete in its entirety the provision for Mental Health, Retardation and Hospitals.

In Section 1, on page 2, between lines 22 and 23 add the following language:

"(4) Mental Health, Retardation and Hospitals \$12,680,000

To provide funds for construction, acquisition and/or renovations and repairs to community facilities for retarded, mentally ill, autistic or chronic alcoholic individuals or for the provision of grants for the same purposes; for the purchase of equipment and furnishings for these facilities; and for the purchase and replacement of equipment and furnishings at MHRH facilities related to national, federal, and state certification and code requirements and other environmental needs.

Funds shall be allocated as follows:

(a) Community Centers

(d) Mental Health	1,000,000
(e) Alcoholics	500,000
(f) Ladd, Zambarano and R.I. Medical Center Complex	
	1,000,000"

On page 11, line 9 delete the following language:

"SECTION 16."


On page 11, line 9 add the following language:

"SECTION 17."

On page 11, following line 8 add the following language:

SECTION 16. Report by Department of Administration. -- The department of administration shall report quarterly to the general assembly on the implementation of Section 1, Mental Health, Retardation and Hospitals, of this act, until such time as all funds available under Section 1, Mental Health, Retardation and Hospitals have been utilized.
