SUPPLEMENTAL JUDGMENT
AND
VACATUR OF OUTSTANDING INJUNCTIVE RELIEF

JUDGMENT BY COURT. This action having come before the Court on Plaintiff's Complaint (ECF No. 1), filed on January 21, 1992, Judgment for the United States et al. having been entered on August 3, 1995 (ECF No. 414), the Court retaining jurisdiction to enforce the Remedial Order of September 2, 1994, which set out a timetable and series of negotiated actions "Defendants are [] Ordered to take . . . to guarantee the statutory and constitutional rights¹ of residents of Arlington Development Center (ADC)" (ECF No. 338 at PageID 2610), remedial action having been taken and the parties having complied with the Exit Plan as set forth on January 17, 2013 (ECF No. 2941), and the Court having held a final hearing on November 8, 2013, in accordance with the Notice of Hearing (ECF No. 2989) requiring

each party to file a Notice of Points of Concern setting out any issues the party has with current compliance, the Notices of Points of Concern having been received (ECF Nos. 3005-07), along with the Final Report and Recommendation of the Court Monitors (see video hearing, available at <http://www.uscourts.gov/Multimedia/Cameras/WesternDistrictofTennessee.aspx>),

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that all outstanding injunctive relief heretofore entered in this case is hereby VACATED and the case is hereby DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE.

The Court retains jurisdiction to resolve any claims or disputes regarding attorney fees related to this case.
