**ORDER**

Before the court is Plaintiffs' motion for class certification. (Doc. # 2.) In the Parties' Rule 26(f) Report, the Parties represent that Plaintiffs may, on or before September 5, 2014, either amend their class certification motion or adopt the motion as it has been submitted.
