17	Plaintiff, in addition to filing its com plaint, motioned the Court for temporary and
18	permanent injunctive relief. The Court denied the notion for temporary injunctive relief, in

20	the parallel proceedings wend their way thr ough state court, Defendants, with Plaintiff's
21	agreement, have filed numerous extensions to file their Answer and response to the motion
22	for injunctive relief.
23	The state court decisions may affect the proceedings in this case. Additionally, the
24	underlying facts may be affected due to the passage of time and other circum stances.
25	Therefore,
26	IT IS ORDERED denying without prejudice Plaintiff's m otion for preliminary
27	injunctive relief.
