 OF SAN FRANCISCO'S SECOND AMENDED

1 WHEREAS, Plaintiff CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO (“Plaintiff” or “San  
2 Francisco”) filed a complaint in this action on January 31, 2017, and filed a Second Amended  
3 Complaint on May 23, 2017;

4 WHEREAS, the Court entered an Order on Plaintiff’s Motion for Summary Judgment  
5 (“Order”) on November 20, 2017, finding that Plaintiff is entitled to summary judgment on Counts  
6 Two and Three of its Second Amended Complaint concerning Section 9(a) of Executive Order 13768  
7 (Dkt. No. 200);<sup>1</sup> and

8 WHEREAS, the Order declined to resolve San Francisco’s claim in Count One regarding 8  
9 U.S.C. § 1373, finding that this claim is “better addressed at the time I consider upcoming motions in  
10 related litigation. *City and County of San Francisco v. Sessions*, No. 17-cv-4642-WHO; *California v.*  
11 *Sessions*, No. 17-cv-4701-WHO (‘the related litigation’); and

12 WHEREAS, the parties agree that San Francisco’s claim for declaratory relief regarding 8  
13 U.S.C. § 1373 shall be raised through an Amended Complaint that San Francisco will file in the case  
14 of *City and County of San Francisco v. Sessions*, No. 17-cv-4642-WHO; and

15 WHEREAS, dismissal of Count One without prejudice will enable this Court to enter final  
16 judgment in the instant case;

17 NOW THEREFORE, the parties hereby stipulate and agree as follows, and respectfully request  
18 that the Court so order:

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24 <sup>1</sup> In its Order, the Court misidentified Counts One and Two in San Francisco’s Second  
25 Amended Complaint as relating to 8 U.S.C. § 1373. (Dkt. No. 200 at 2, fn. 1 & 27.) Only Count One  
26 in San Francisco’s Second Amended Complaint relates to Section 1373, while Counts Two and Three  
27 relate to the Executive Order. (Dkt. No. 105.) The analysis in the Order makes clear that the Court is  
granting summary judgment on Counts Two and Three, leaving only Count One to be resolved in the  
future.

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3 Count One of Plaintiff's Second Amended Complaint in this action is hereby dismissed without  
4 prejudice.

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
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**ORDER**
