**ORDER REGARDING CASE
MANAGEMENT CONFERENCE**

Re: Dkt. No. 64

On April 18, 2017, I continued the hearing on plaintiffs’ motion for preliminary injunction to May 31, 2017 at 2:00 p.m., anticipating that the continuance would “allow resolution of appellate proceedings arising from *Hawaii v. Trump*, ___ F. Supp. 3d ___, 2017 WL 1167383 (D. Haw. Mar. 29, 2017), *appeal docketed*, No. 17-5589 (9th Cir. Mar. 30, 2017) prior to the hearing.” Order Continuing Hearings (Dkt. No. 63). I indicated that if the Ninth Circuit had not ruled by May 24, 2017, the hearing might be continued again. *Id.*

In light of the Fourth Circuit’s ruling yesterday in *International Refugee Assistance Project v. Trump*, ___ F.3d ___, 2017 WL 2273306 (4th Cir. May 25, 2017), and the government’s indication that it will seek review in the United States Supreme Court, the hearing on plaintiffs’ motion is vacated for the time being. The parties, however, should appear on May 31, 2017 at 2:00 p.m. for a Case Management Conference to discuss what, if anything, should occur in this matter during the pendency of *International Refugee Assistance Project v. Trump* and *Hawaii v. Trump*. A Joint Case Management Statement describing the parties’ perspectives is due by noon
