On this 25th day of June, 1947, 19, came the United States Attorney,  
and the defendant **Frank Martinez Mendosa** appearing in proper person, and  
without counsel and defendant having been informed of his right to counsel  
and a jury trial and having waived the same.

The defendant having been convicted on his plea of guilty of the offense charged  
in the first count in the above-entitled cause, to wit:  
Having on or about November 15th, 1942, knowingly departed from the  
United States to Mexico, for the purpose of evading service in the land  
or naval forces of the United States and having remained there until on  
or about November 1st, 1946,

and the defendant having been now asked whether he has anything to say why judgment  
should not be pronounced against him, and no sufficient cause to the contrary being shown or  
appearing to the Court, IT IS BY THE COURT

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the defendant, having been found guilty of said offenses, is hereby com-  
mitted to the custody of the Attorney General or his authorized representative for imprisonment for the  
period of one year and one day in an institution of the penitentiary  
type, on the first count.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the second and third counts be dismissed,  
it appearing to the court that the offenses charged therein arose  
out of the same circumstances.

The court does not deem a reference necessary to the Probation Office  
prior to sentence.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk deliver a certified copy of this judgment and commitment to  
the United States Marshal or other qualified officer and that the same shall serve as the commitment  
herein on the first count.
