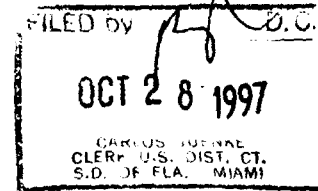




**FINAL JUDGMENT AND RULE 54(b) CERTIFICATION AS TO COUNT ONE**
