JOINT STIPULATION OF MOOTNESS

Plaintiff, Americans for Immigrant Justice, Inc., and Defendants, United States Customs and Border Protection and the United States Department of Homeland Security (together, the “Parties”), by and through their respective undersigned counsel, hereby stipulate that there are no further issues remaining for the Court to resolve regarding the Freedom of Information Act (5 U.S.C. § 552, *et seq.* (“FOIA”)) request underlying this lawsuit, and that this case may be dismissed as moot.

Further, the Parties have resolved the issue of Plaintiff’s attorney’s fees and costs. Defendants agree to pay Plaintiff the sum of \$8,750.00 in full satisfaction of Plaintiff’s demand to recover its fees and costs.
