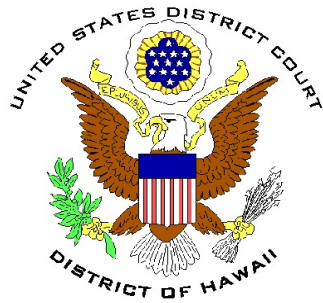
**ORDER GRANTING PLAINTIFFS' MOTION TO LIFT STAY AND FOR
