ORDER

It is hereby ORDERED that Plaintiffs are granted leave to file the Motion for Preliminary Injunction proposed in Notice of Intent to File, ECF No. 3. As agreed upon by the parties, Plaintiffs' Motion will be limited to joining the Motion for a Preliminary Injunction to be filed by the Plaintiffs in TDC-17-0361 *International Refugee Assistance Project et al. v. Trump et al.* and filing a 10-page Supplement limited to issues not raised in the International Refugee Assistance Project Motion, such as standing and harm to Plaintiffs. That Supplement is due **October 10, 2017 at 12:00 noon**. Defendants will file a consolidated Response to the Motions filed in this case and in TDC-17-0361 *International Refugee Assistance Project et al. v. Trump*

et. al. and TDC-17-2921 *Iranian Alliances Across Borders et al. v. Trump et al.* on the briefing schedule and within the parameters previously set forth in those cases. The Zakzok Plaintiffs will be permitted to file a separate Reply that need not be limited to issues raised in their Supplement, but which may not raise any new issues. That Reply must not exceed 10 pages and must be filed by **October 14, 2017 at 12:00 noon.**
