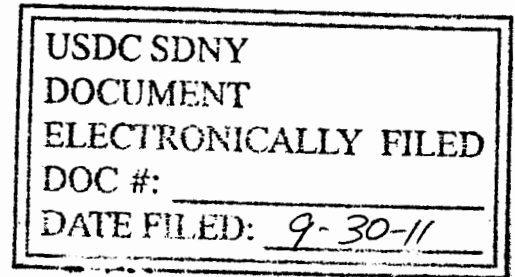

On June 26, 2007, the parties in this case entered into a Stipulation settling the plaintiffs' claims. The Stipulation provided that it would govern the parties' conduct for four years and that, at the end of four years, the plaintiffs could move in accordance with certain terms to extend the Stipulation. On June 23, 2011, the plaintiffs moved to extend the stipulation. The Commissioner of the New York City Human Resources Administration settled with plaintiffs, extending the Stipulation until February 15, 2013. The New York State defendants, in contrast, opposed extension. The parties extensively briefed the motion, and the Court held both an oral argument and an

evidentiary hearing. Having now fully considered the matter, the Court hereby extends the Stipulation against the State defendants until February 15, 2013. A written opinion stating the reasons for this ruling will issue in due course. In the interim, the Court directs the parties to jointly call Chambers to schedule such additional proceedings, if any, as may be required.
