ORDER

KAPLAN, J.

*1 On September 24, 2004, this Court granted partial summary judgment in favor of defendant on most of plaintiffs' claims under the Freedom of Information Act, but granted summary judgment in plaintiffs' favor with

respect to, and directed defendant to produce by today, an April 2002 opinion of the Office of Legal Counsel ("OLC"). *National Council of La Raza v. Department of Justice*, No. 03 Civ. 2559(LAK), 2004 WL 2153929 (S.D.N.Y. Sept. 24, 2004). The Court assumes familiarity with that opinion. Defendant now moves for reconsideration of so much of the decision as directed production of the OLC opinion, including *in camera* inspection of the document, and for a stay while it decides whether to take an appeal.

Defendant shall submit the OLC opinion to the Court for *in camera* inspection no later than October 14, 2004 at 3 p.m.

The Department's obligation to produce the document to the plaintiffs is stayed to and including October 24, 2004 to permit further consideration of whether to appeal. The Court will indicate whether a further stay will be granted when it rules on the motion for reconsideration following *in camera* inspection.
